





## Strengthening Capacity of Social Worker for Child Protection in Emergencies

Oct 2019 - Dec 2020

The Strengthening Capacity of Social Worker for Child Protection in Emergencies is a project supported by UNICEF to provide increased capacity for social workers in the Social Ministry of Indonesia. This project consists of three outputs that are 1.) A set of CPiE training manual comprising of training materials, handbook trainers, and trains reference is developed, 2.) Fifty MOSA's social workers and key partners have improved capacity in delivery services for child protection in emergency responses, and 3.) Twenty CPiE trainers equipped with skills and knowledge to deliver CPiE training utilising the developed CPiE training manual set. Training is done by online and face to face.
